## A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to prevent the misuse of certain anti-racketeering laws.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RACKETEERING DEFINITION.**

4 Section 1961(5) of title 18, United States Code, is  
5 amended by inserting “a profit-seeking purpose and” after  
6 “requires”.

1 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2       The amendment made by this Act shall apply with  
3 respect to cases arising on or after the date of the enact-  
4 ment of this Act and to cases pending on that date.
