## A BILL

To designate the United States courthouse under construction in White Plains, New York, as the “Thurgood Marshall United States Courthouse”.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4       The United States courthouse under construction at  
5       300 Quarropas Street in White Plains, New York, shall  
6       be known and designated as the “Thurgood Marshall  
7       United States Courthouse”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the United  
4 States courthouse referred to in section 1 shall be deemed  
5 to be a reference to the “Thurgood Marshall United States  
6 Courthouse”.
