A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to modify the eligibility requirements for appointment as the Surgeon General of the Public Health Service.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MODIFICATION IN ELIGIBILITY REQUIRE-**
4 **MENTS FOR APPOINTMENT AS SURGEON**
5 **GENERAL OF PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE.**

6 Section 204 of the Public Health Service Act (42
7 U.S.C. 205) is amended in the second sentence by striking
8 “are members of the Regular Corps,” and inserting the
9 following: “are members of the Regular Corps and have

1 been continuously on active duty as such members for not
2 less than 20 years,”.

3 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

4 The amendment made by section 1 is effective in the
5 case of any individual holding the position of Surgeon
6 General of the Public Health Service on or after the date
7 of the enactment of this Act.

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
