Mr. KANJORSKI (for himself, Mr. DEFazio, and Mr. SHAYS) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend section 3056 of title 18, United States Code, to limit secret service protection of former Presidents when they are traveling to engage in income-producing activities.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That section 3056 of title 18, United States Code, is
4 amended by adding at the end the following:

5 “(e) Protection, other than on a reimbursable basis,
6 shall not be provided under subsection (a)(3) or (a)(4) to
7 an individual who is away from that individual’s domicile,
8 as determined by the Secretary of the Treasury, if the

1 former President, or any member of the former Presi-
2 dent's family, directly or indirectly obtains income from
3 activities while so away.".
