To express the sense of the Congress that the Administrator of the Small Business Administration should be designated by the President as a member of the Cabinet and to raise the annual rate of basic pay of the Administrator.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PARTICIPATION OF SBA ADMINISTRATOR IN**
4 **CABINET.**

5 It is the sense of the Congress that the Administrator
6 of the Small Business Administration should be des-
7 ignated by the President—

1 (1) as a member of, and a full participant in
2 activities of, the Cabinet; and

3 (2) as the President’s principal adviser on all
4 matters relating to small business.

5 **SEC. 2. PAY STATUS COMMENSURATE WITH CABINET STA-**
6 **TUS.**

7 (a) EXECUTIVE LEVEL I.—Section 5312 of title 5,
8 United States Code (relating to executive level I), is
9 amended by adding at the end the following new item:

10 “Administrator of the Small Business Adminis-
11 tration.”.

12 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 5314 of
13 such title (relating to executive level III) is amended by
14 striking the following item:

15 “Administrator of the Small Business Adminis-
16 tration.”.
