A BILL

To authorize the adjustment of the boundaries of the South Dakota portion of the Sioux Ranger District of Custer National Forest, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SIOUX RANGER DISTRICT BOUNDARY ADJUST-**
4 **MENT.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—In accordance with the Act enti-
6 tled “An Act to consolidate national forest lands”, ap-
7 proved March 20, 1922 (16 U.S.C. 485 et seq.), and in
8 exchange for national forest lands in Custer National For-
9 est, the Secretary of Agriculture may accept title to any

1 lands located within five miles of the exterior boundaries
2 of the South Dakota portion of the Sioux Ranger District
3 of Custer National Forest that are not owned by the
4 United States and that are found by the Secretary of Agri-
5 culture to be chiefly valuable for national forest purposes.

6 (b) INCORPORATION INTO CUSTER NATIONAL FOR-
7 EST.—Upon acceptance of title by the Secretary of Agri-
8 culture, lands conveyed to the United States in accordance
9 with subsection (a) shall become part of the Custer
10 National Forest.
