A BILL

To utilize the most current Federal census data in the distribution of Federal funds for agriculture, nutrition, and forestry.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Agriculture, Nutrition,
5 and Forestry Fair Share Act of 1993”.

6 **SEC. 2. AGRICULTURE, NUTRITION, AND FORESTRY.**

7 (a) AGRICULTURE EXPERIMENT STATIONS.—Section
8 3 of the Act entitled “An act to establish agricultural ex-

1 periment stations in connection with the colleges estab-
2 lished in the several States under the provisions of an act
3 approved July second, eighteen hundred and sixty-two,
4 and of the acts supplementary thereto”, approved March
5 2, 1887 (commonly known as the Hatch Act of 1887) (7
6 U.S.C. 361c(c)(2)) is amended in subsection (c)(2), by
7 striking “as determined by the last preceding decennial
8 census current at the time each such additional sum is
9 first appropriated” each place it appears and inserting in
10 lieu thereof “according to the latest available estimates
11 prepared by the Department of Commerce”.

12 (b) AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH AT 1890 LAND
13 GRANT COLLEGES, INCLUDING TUSKEGEE INSTITUTE.—
14 Section 1445 of the National Agricultural Research Ex-
15 tension, and Teaching Policy Act of 1977 (7 U.S.C.
16 3222(b)(2)(B)) is amended in subsection (b)(2)(B), by
17 striking “as determined by the last preceding decennial
18 census current at the time each such additional sum is
19 first appropriated” each place it appears and inserting in
20 each such place “according to the latest available esti-
21 mates prepared by the Department of Commerce”.

22 (c) FEDERAL EXTENSION SERVICE.—Section 3 of
23 the Act of May 8, 1914 (7 U.S.C. 343(c)(2)) (commonly
24 known as the Smith-Lever Act) is amended in subsection
25 (c)(2)—

1 (1) by striking “as determined by the census”
2 each place it appears and inserting in each such
3 place “according to the latest available estimates
4 prepared by the Department of Commerce”;

5 (2) by striking “on the basis of the decennial
6 census current at the time such appropriation is
7 first made” and inserting in lieu thereof “according
8 to the latest available estimates prepared by the De-
9 partment of Commerce”; and

10 (3) by striking “on the basis of decennial cen-
11 sus current at the time such increase is first appro-
12 priated” and inserting in lieu thereof “according to
13 the latest available estimates prepared by the De-
14 partment of Commerce”.

15 (d) NUTRITION EDUCATION PROGRAM.—Section
16 1425 of the National Agricultural Research, Extension,
17 and Teaching Policy Act of 1977 (7 U.S.C.
18 3175(c)(2)(B)(ii)), is amended in subsection (b) by strik-
19 ing “as determined by the last preceding decennial census
20 at the time each such additional amount is first appro-
21 priated” and inserting in lieu thereof “according to the
22 latest estimates prepared by the Department of
23 Commerce”.
