Mr. ENGLISH of Oklahoma introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To prohibit the transportation, treatment, storage, or disposal of hazardous waste outside the State in which the waste was generated.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON TRANSPORTATION, TREAT-**
4 **MENT, STORAGE, OR DISPOSAL OF HAZARD-**
5 **OUS WASTE OUTSIDE OF STATE IN WHICH**
6 **WASTE WAS GENERATED.**

7 (a) AMENDMENT TO SUBTITLE C.—Subtitle C of the
8 Solid Waste Disposal Act is amended by adding at the
9 end the following new section:

1 **“SEC. 3021. PROHIBITION ON TRANSPORTATION, TREAT-**
2 **MENT, STORAGE, OR DISPOSAL OF HAZARD-**
3 **OUS WASTE OUTSIDE OF STATE IN WHICH**
4 **WASTE WAS GENERATED.**

5 “Effective January 1, 1994, hazardous waste may
6 not be transported, treated, stored, or disposed of outside
7 the State in which the waste was generated.”.

8 (b) TECHNICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of contents
9 for subtitle C of such Act (contained in section 1001 of
10 such Act) is amended by adding at the end the following
11 new item:

“Sec. 3021. Prohibition on transportation, treatment, storage, or disposal of
hazardous waste outside of State in which waste was gen-
erated.”.
