AMENDMENTS

In the House of Representatives, U. S.,

Resolved, That the House agree to the amendment of the Senate to the bill (H.R. 821) entitled “An Act to amend title 38, United States Code, to extend eligibility for burial in national cemeteries to persons who have 20 years of service creditable for retired pay as members of a reserve component of the Armed Forces”, with the following

AMENDMENTS:

In lieu of the matter inserted by said amendment,
insert:

1 ***SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN RESERVISTS AND DE-***
2 ***PENDENTS FOR BURIAL IN NATIONAL CEME-***
3 ***TERIES.***

4 *(a) RESERVISTS.—Section 2402 of title 38, United*
5 *States Code, is amended by inserting after paragraph (6)*
6 *the following new paragraph (7):*

7 *“(7) Any person who at the time of death was*
8 *entitled to retired pay under chapter 67 of title 10 or*
9 *would have been entitled to retired pay under that*
10 *chapter but for the fact that the person was under 60*
11 *years of age.”.*

1 (b) *DEPENDENTS*.—Paragraph (5) of such section is
2 amended by inserting “and paragraph (7)” after “para-
3 graphs (1) through (4)”.

Amend the title so as to read: “An Act to amend title 38, United States Code, to extend eligibility for burial in national cemeteries to persons who have 20 years of service creditable for retired pay as members of a reserve component of the Armed Forces and to their dependents.”.
