A BILL

To authorize additional appropriations to increase border patrol personnel to 6,800 by the end of fiscal year 1995 and to make available amounts in the Department of Justice Assets Forfeiture Fund for the additional border patrol personnel.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INCREASE IN BORDER PATROL PERSONNEL TO**

4 **6,800.**

5 There are authorized to be appropriated such addi-
6 tional sums as may be necessary to provide for an author-
7 ized personnel level of 6,800 for the border patrol of the

1 Immigration and Naturalization Service by not later than
2 October 1, 1995.

3 **SEC. 2. AVAILABILITY OF AMOUNTS IN THE DEPARTMENT**
4 **OF JUSTICE ASSETS FORFEITURE FUND TO**
5 **PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL BORDER PATROL**
6 **PERSONNEL.**

7 Section 524(c) of title 28, United States Code, is
8 amended by adding at the end the following new para-
9 graph:

10 “(12) In addition to the purposes specified in para-
11 graph (1), the Fund shall be available (to the extent pro-
12 vided in appropriations acts) to the extent required to pro-
13 vide for an authorized personnel level of 6,800 for the
14 border patrol of the Immigration and Naturalization
15 Service.”.
