To authorize the Air Force Memorial Foundation to establish a memorial in the District of Columbia or its environs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH MEMORIAL.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Air Force Memorial Founda-
5 tion is authorized to establish a memorial on Federal land
6 in the District of Columbia or its environs to honor the
7 men and women who have served in the United States Air
8 Force and its predecessors.

1 (b) COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COMMEMO-
2 RATIVE WORKS.—The establishment of the memorial shall
3 be in accordance with the Act entitled “An Act to provide
4 standards for placement of commemorative works on cer-
5 tain Federal lands in the District of Columbia and its en-
6 viron, and for other purposes”, approved November 14,
7 1986 (40 U.S.C. 1001 et seq.).

8 **SEC. 2. PAYMENT OF EXPENSES.**

9 The Air Force Memorial Foundation shall be solely
10 responsible for acceptance of contributions for, and pay-
11 ment of the expenses of, the establishment of the memo-
12 rial. No Federal funds may be used to pay any expense
13 of the establishment of the memorial.

14 **SEC. 3. DEPOSIT OF EXCESS FUNDS.**

15 If, upon payment of all expenses of the establishment
16 of the memorial (including the maintenance and preserva-
17 tion amount provided for in section 8(b) of the Act re-
18 ferred to in section 1(b)), or upon expiration of the author-
19 ity for the memorial under section 10(b) of such Act, there
20 remains a balance of funds received for the establishment
21 of the memorial, the Air Force Memorial Foundation shall
22 transmit the amount of the balance to the Secretary of

1 the Treasury for deposit in the account provided for in
2 section 8(b)(1) of such Act.
