A BILL

To amend the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 and the National School Lunch Act to extend certain authorities contained in such Acts through the fiscal year 1998.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF CHILD NUTRITION ACT OF 1966.**

2 (a) **STARTUP COSTS FOR SCHOOL BREAKFAST PRO-**
3 **GRAMS.**—The first sentence of section 4(g)(1) of the Child
4 Nutrition Act of 1966 (42 U.S.C. 1773(g)(1)) is amended
5 by striking “\$3,000,000” and all that follows through
6 “1994” and inserting “\$5,000,000 for each of the fiscal
7 years 1991 through 1995 and such sums as may be nec-
8 essary for each of the fiscal years 1996 through 1998”.

9 (b) **STATE ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES.**—Section
10 7(h) of the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 (42 U.S.C.
11 1776(h)) is amended by striking “1994” and inserting
12 “1998”.

13 (c) **SPECIAL SUPPLEMENTAL FOOD PROGRAM**
14 **(WIC).**—Section 17 of the Child Nutrition Act of 1966
15 (42 U.S.C. 1786) is amended—

16 (1) in subsection (g)(1), by striking “each of”
17 and all that follows through “1994” and inserting
18 “each succeeding fiscal year ending before October
19 1, 1998”;

20 (2) in subsection (h)(2)(A), by striking “each
21 of” and all that follows through “1994” and insert-
22 ing “the fiscal year 1990 and each succeeding fiscal
23 year ending before October 1, 1998”; and

24 (3) in subsection (m)(10)(A) by striking
25 “\$3,000,000” and all that follows through the pe-
26 riod and inserting “\$6,500,000 for the fiscal year

1 1993, \$8,000,000 for each of the fiscal years 1994
2 and 1995, and such sums as may be necessary for
3 each of the fiscal years 1996, 1997, and 1998.”.

4 (d) NUTRITION EDUCATION AND TRAINING.—The
5 first sentence of section 19(i)(2)(A) is amended—

6 (1) in clause (iii), by striking “and”;

7 (2) in clause (iv), by striking “1993 and 1994.”
8 and inserting “1993, 1994, and 1995; and”; and

9 (3) by adding at the end the following new
10 clause:

11 “(v) such sums as may be necessary for
12 each succeeding fiscal year ending before Octo-
13 ber 1, 1998”.

14 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF NATIONAL SCHOOL LUNCH ACT.**

15 (a) SUMMER FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM FOR CHIL-
16 DREN.—Section 13(r) of the National School Lunch Act
17 (42 U.S.C. 1761(r)) is amended by striking “1994” and
18 inserting “1998”.

19 (b) DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM.—Section 14(a) of the
20 National School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1762a(a)) is
21 amended by striking “1994” and inserting “1998”.

22 (c) STATEWIDE DEMONSTRATION PROJECTS UNDER
23 CHILD AND ADULT CARE FOOD PROGRAM.—Section
24 17(p)(5) of the National School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C.

1 1766(p)(5)) is amended by striking “1994” and inserting
2 “1998”.

3 (d) PILOT PROJECTS.—Section 18 of the National
4 School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1769) is amended—

5 (1) in the first sentence of subsection (b)(1), by
6 striking “1994” and inserting “1998”; and

7 (2) in subsection (c)—

8 (A) in paragraph (5)(A), by striking “and
9 not less than \$800,000 in fiscal year 1994” and
10 inserting “not less than \$800,000 in each of the
11 fiscal years 1994 and 1995, and such sums as
12 may be necessary in each of the fiscal years
13 1996 through 1998”; and

14 (B) in paragraph (6), by striking “1994”
15 and inserting “1998”.

16 (e) TRAINING, TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE, AND FOOD
17 SERVICE MANAGEMENT INSTITUTE.—Section 21(e) of the
18 National School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1769b-1(e)(2)) is
19 amended—

20 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “and 1994”
21 and inserting “1994, and 1995, and such sums as
22 may be necessary in each of the fiscal years 1996
23 through 1998”; and

24 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “and 1994”
25 and inserting “1994, and 1995, and such sums as

1 may be necessary in each of the fiscal years 1996
2 through 1998”.
