To amend title 10, United States Code, to provide for appointments to the military service academies by the Resident Representative to the United States for the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.

Mr. DE LUGO (for himself, Mr. MILLER of California, Mr. UNDERWOOD, Mr. FALEOMAVAEGA, Mr. GALLEGLY, and Mr. MURPHY) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to provide for appointments to the military service academies by the Resident Representative to the United States for the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. APPOINTMENTS TO MILITARY SERVICE ACAD-**
4 **EMIES BY THE RESIDENT REPRESENTATIVE**
5 **TO THE UNITED STATES FOR THE COMMON-**
6 **WEALTH OF THE NORTHERN MARIANA IS-**
7 **LANDS.**

8 (a) UNITED STATES MILITARY ACADEMY.—

1 (1) APPOINTMENT AUTHORITY.—Subsection (a)
2 of section 4342 of title 10, United States Code, is
3 amended by striking out the sentence following the
4 clauses of such subsection and inserting in lieu
5 thereof the following:

6 “(10) One cadet from the Commonwealth of the
7 Northern Mariana Islands, nominated by the Resi-
8 dent Representative to the United States for the
9 Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands in
10 consultation with the Governor of the Common-
11 wealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.

12 “Each person specified in clauses (3) through (10) who
13 is entitled to nominate a candidate for admission to the
14 Academy may nominate a principal candidate and nine al-
15 ternates for each vacancy that is available to the person
16 under this subsection.”.

17 (2) DOMICILE OF CADETS.—Subsection (f) of
18 such section is amended to read as follows:

19 “(f) Each candidate for admission nominated under
20 clauses (3) through (10) of subsection (a) must be domi-
21 ciled—

22 “(1) in the State, or in the congressional dis-
23 trict, from which the candidate is nominated; or

24 “(2) in the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico,
25 American Samoa, Guam, the Virgin Islands, or the

1 Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, if
2 the candidate is nominated from one of those
3 places.”.

4 (3) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—(A) Sub-
5 section (d) of such section is amended by striking
6 out “(9)” and inserting in lieu thereof “(10)”.

7 (B) Section 4343 of such title is amended by
8 striking out “(8) of section 4342(a)” and inserting
9 in lieu thereof “(10) of section 4342(a)”.

10 (b) UNITED STATES NAVAL ACADEMY.—

11 (1) APPOINTMENT AUTHORITY.—Section
12 6954(a) of title 10, United States Code, is amended
13 by striking out the sentence following the clauses of
14 such subsection and inserting in lieu thereof the fol-
15 lowing:

16 “(10) One from the Commonwealth of the
17 Northern Mariana Islands, nominated by the Resi-
18 dent Representative to the United States for the
19 Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands in
20 consultation with the Governor of the Common-
21 wealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.

22 “Each person specified in clauses (3) through (10) who
23 is entitled to nominate a candidate for admission to the
24 Academy may nominate a principal candidate and nine al-

1 ternates for each vacancy that is available to the person
2 under this subsection.”.

3 (2) DOMICILE OF MIDSHIPMEN.—Subsection
4 (b) of section 6958 of such title is amended to read
5 as follows:

6 “(b) Each candidate for admission nominated under
7 clauses (3) through (10) of subsection (a) of section 6954
8 of this title must be domiciled—

9 “(1) in the State, or in the congressional dis-
10 trict, from which the candidate is nominated; or

11 “(2) in the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico,
12 American Samoa, Guam, the Virgin Islands, or the
13 Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, if
14 the candidate is nominated from one of those
15 places.”.

16 (4) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—(A) Section
17 6954(d) of such title is amended by striking out
18 “(9)” and inserting in lieu thereof “(10)”.

19 (B) Section 6956(b) of such title is amended by
20 striking out “(8) of section 6954(a)” and inserting
21 in lieu thereof “(10) of section 6954(a)”.

22 (c) UNITED STATES AIR FORCE ACADEMY.—

23 (1) APPOINTMENT AUTHORITY.—Subsection (a)
24 of section 9342 of title 10, United States Code, is
25 amended by striking out the sentence following the

1 clauses of such subsection and inserting in lieu
2 thereof the following:

3 “(10) One cadet from the Commonwealth of the
4 Northern Mariana Islands, nominated by the Resi-
5 dent Representative to the United States for the
6 Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands in
7 consultation with the Governor of the Common-
8 wealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.

9 “Each person specified in clauses (3) through (10) who
10 is entitled to nominate a candidate for admission to the
11 Academy may nominate a principal candidate and nine al-
12 ternates for each vacancy that is available to the person
13 under this subsection.”.

14 (2) DOMICILE OF CADETS.—Subsection (f) of
15 such section is amended to read as follows:

16 “(f) Each candidate for admission nominated under
17 clauses (3) through (10) of subsection (a) must be domi-

1 (3) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—(A) Sub-
2 section (d) of such section is amended by striking
3 out “(9)” and inserting in lieu thereof “(10)”.

4 (B) Section 9343 of such title is amended by
5 striking out “(8) of section 9342(a)” and inserting
6 in lieu thereof “(10) of section 9342(a)”.

7 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
8 this section shall apply with respect to the nomination of
9 candidates for appointment to the United States Military
10 Academy, the United States Naval Academy, and the
11 United States Air Force Academy for classes entering one
12 of these military service academies after the date of the
13 enactment of this Act.
