A BILL

To disregard cost-of-living adjustments in tier 1 railroad retirement benefits in determining eligibility for supplemental security income benefits under Medicaid.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENTS IN TIER 1 RAIL-**
4 **ROAD RETIREMENT BENEFITS DISREGARDED**
5 **IN DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY FOR SUPPLE-**
6 **MENTAL SECURITY INCOME BENEFITS**
7 **UNDER MEDICAID.**

8 Section 503 of Public Law 94-566 (90 Stat. 2685)
9 is amended by adding at the end thereof the following new

1 sentence: “The preceding provisions of this section shall
2 be applied by treating references to monthly insurance
3 benefits under title II of the Social Security Act as includ-
4 ing references to tier 1 railroad retirement benefits (as
5 defined in section 86(d)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code
6 of 1986); except that in applying such treatment the 1st
7 month beginning after the date of the enactment of this
8 sentence shall be substituted for ‘June 1977’ and ‘October
9 1990’ shall be substituted for ‘April 1977.’”
