Mrs. MINK introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To provide that individuals who exhaust their rights to disaster unemployment benefits shall be entitled to emergency unemployment benefits.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That (a) section 101 of the Emergency Unemployment
4 Compensation Act of 1991 (Public Law 102–164, as
5 amended) is amended by adding at the end thereof the
6 following new subsection:

7 “(g) TREATMENT OF INDIVIDUALS WHO EXHAUST
8 DISASTER UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS.—Any individual
9 who exhausts such individual’s rights to disaster unem-
10 ployment assistance under section 410 of the Robert T.

1 Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act
2 shall be entitled to emergency compensation under this
3 Act in the same manner as if—

4 “(1) such assistance were regular compensation
5 under the State law, and

6 “(2) the work and wages taken into account in
7 determining the amount of such assistance had been
8 covered by the State law.

9 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, to the extent
10 that any payments under this Act to any State are re-
11 quired by reason of this subsection, such payments shall
12 be made from funds available for purposes of providing
13 assistance under such section 410.”

14 (b) The amendment made by subsection (a) shall
15 apply to weeks beginning after March 6, 1993.
