RESOLUTION

Providing amounts from the contingent fund of the House for the expenses of investigations and studies by certain committees of the House in the first session of the One Hundred Third Congress.

25 *training under paragraph (2) of the first section.*

14 *SEC. 5. (a) In addition to the amounts made available*
15 *for other committees under this resolution, there shall be*
16 *paid out of the contingent fund of the House not more than*
17 *\$495,000 for one-half of the expenses of investigations and*
18 *studies by the Joint Committee on the Organization of the*
19 *Congress (hereinafter in this section referred to as the*
20 *"Committee"), including expenses for procurement of con-*
21 *sultant services under section 202(i) of the Legislative Reor-*
22 *ganization Act of 1946.*

23 (b) *Not more than \$50,000 of the amount specified in*
24 *subsection (a) may be used for consultant services referred*
25 *to in such subsection.*

1 (c) *Notwithstanding sections 7 and 8—*

2 (1) *payments under this section shall be made on*
3 *vouchers signed by the House of Representatives co-*
4 *chairman of the Committee and approved by the*
5 *Committee on House Administration; and*

6 (2) *amounts shall be available under this section*
7 *for investigations and studies carried out during the*
8 *period beginning at noon on January 3, 1993, and*
9 *ending on December 31, 1993.*

10 *SEC. 6. The Committee on House Administration—*

11 (1) *shall, through House Information Systems,*
12 *develop, operate, maintain, and improve computer*
13 *and information services for the House, including di-*
14 *rect computer and information systems support for*
15 *Members, committees, administrative offices, and*
16 *other governmental entities, and shall conduct nec-*
17 *essary investigations and studies of such services;*

18 (2) *is authorized to receive reimbursement for*
19 *services under paragraph (1) and to expend amounts*
20 *so reimbursed in accordance with policies of the com-*
21 *mittee; and*

22 (3) *is authorized to provide for professional de-*
23 *velopment programs, office and personnel manage-*
24 *ment consultation services, and periodic publication*

1 *of handbooks, guides, bulletins, and other items nec-*
2 *essary for the House.*

3 *SEC. 7. Payments under this resolution shall be made*
4 *on vouchers authorized by the committee involved, signed*
5 *by the chairman of such committee, and approved by the*
6 *Committee on House Administration.*

7 *SEC. 8. Amounts shall be available under this resolu-*
8 *tion for investigations and studies carried out during the*
9 *period beginning at noon on January 3, 1993, and ending*
10 *immediately before noon on January 3, 1994.*

11 *SEC. 9. Amounts made available under this resolution*
12 *shall be expended in accordance with regulations prescribed*
13 *by the Committee on House Administration.*

14 *SEC. 10. The Committee on House Administration*
15 *shall have authority to make adjustments in amounts for*
16 *investigations and studies under sections 2 and 5, if nec-*
17 *essary to comply with an order of the President issued*
18 *under section 254 of the Balanced Budget and Emergency*
19 *Deficit Control Act of 1985 or to conform to any reduction*
20 *in appropriations for the purposes of such sections 2 and*
21 *5.*
