RESOLUTION

Requiring that the concurrent resolution on the budget for the fiscal year 1994 establish outlay caps over a 5-year period.

1 *Resolved*, That any concurrent resolution on the
2 budget for fiscal year 1994 agreed to by the House of Rep-
3 resentatives and the Senate shall provide that—

4 (1) total outlays for fiscal year 1994 not exceed
5 104 percent of total outlays for fiscal year 1993;

6 (2) total outlays for fiscal year 1995 not exceed
7 total outlays for fiscal year 1994;

8 (3) total outlays for fiscal year 1996 not exceed
9 104 percent of total outlays for fiscal year 1995;

- 1 (4) total outlays for fiscal year 1997 not exceed
- 2 total outlays for fiscal year 1996; and
- 3 (5) total outlays for fiscal year 1998 not exceed
- 4 104 percent of total outlays for fiscal year 1997.
