Mr. BEILENSON, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2403) making appropriations for the Treasury Department, the United States Postal Service, the Executive Office of the President, and certain Independent Agencies, for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1994, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2403) making appropriations for

1 the Treasury Department, the United States Postal Serv-
2 ice, the Executive Office of the President, and certain
3 Independent Agencies, for the fiscal year ending Septem-
4 ber 30, 1994, and for other purposes. The first reading
5 of the bill shall be dispensed with. Points of order against
6 consideration of the bill for failure to comply with clause
7 7 of rule XXI are waived. General debate shall be confined
8 to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided
9 and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority
10 member of the Committee on Appropriations. After gen-
11 eral debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
12 under the five-minute rule. Points of order under clause
13 2 or 6 of rule XXI against provisions in the bill are waived
14 except as follows: beginning with “*Provided*” on page 17,
15 line 2 through “Code:” on line 5; beginning on page 19,
16 line 22, through page 20, line 16; and beginning on page
17 62, line 22, through page 63, line 2. Where points of order
18 are waived against only part of a paragraph, a point of
19 order against matter in the balance of the paragraph may
20 be applied only within the balance of the paragraph and
21 not against the entire paragraph. It shall be in order to
22 consider the amendment printed in the report of the Com-
23 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution if offered
24 by a named proponent or a designee. That amendment
25 shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time

1 specified in the report equally divided and controlled by
2 its proponent and an opponent, and shall not be subject
3 to amendment. All points of order against the amendment
4 printed in the report are waived. At the conclusion of con-
5 sideration of the bill for amendment the Committee shall
6 rise and report the bill to the House with such amend-
7 ments as may have been adopted. The previous question
8 shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments
9 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except
10 one motion to recommit.
