Waiving certain points of order against the bill (H.R. 2445) making appropriations for energy and water development for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1994, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That during consideration in the Committee  
2 of the Whole House on the State of the Union of the bill  
3 (H.R. 2445) making appropriations for energy and water  
4 development for the fiscal year ending September 30,  
5 1994, and for other purposes, all points of order against  
6 provisions in the bill for failure to comply with clause 2

1 or 6 of rule XXI are waived except as follows: beginning  
2 on page 35, line 17, through line 25. No amendment af-  
3 fecting the subject of the Superconducting Super Collider  
4 (other than as part of general reduction of amounts pro-  
5 vided in the bill) shall be in order except one offered by  
6 Representative Slattery of Kansas or a designee. That  
7 amendment shall be debatable for one hour equally divided  
8 and controlled by its proponent and an opponent and shall  
9 not be subject to amendment or to a demand for division  
10 of the question in the House or in the Committee of the  
11 Whole.
