Mr. WALKER submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

## RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to create the Committee on the Investigation of Corrupt Practices.

1       *Resolved*, That clause 1 of rule X of the Rules of the  
2 House of Representatives is amended by redesignating  
3 paragraphs (l) through (v) as paragraphs (m) through  
4 (w), respectively, and by inserting after paragraph (k) the  
5 following new paragraph:

6       “(l)(1) COMMITTEE ON THE INVESTIGATION OF COR-  
7 RUPT PRACTICES, consisting of the following Members:

8               “(A) 6 Members who are not members of the  
9 same political party as the President, to be ap-  
10 pointed by the majority leader or minority leader, as

1 the case may be, and 1 of whom he shall designate  
2 as chairman; and

3 “(B) 5 Members who are members of the same  
4 political party as the President, to be appointed by  
5 the majority leader or minority leader, as the case  
6 may be.

7 “(2) The committee shall have the duty—

8 “(A) to investigate, at the instigation of its  
9 chairman or upon receipt of a written request made  
10 by at least 50 Members of the House and transmit-  
11 ted to the committee by 1 such Member, corrupt  
12 practices in the executive branch of the Government;  
13 and

14 “(B) to report to the House the results of its  
15 investigations; and

16 “(C) to recommend to the House such legisla-  
17 tive or administrative actions as it deems appro-  
18 priate.”.
