Mr. HALL of Ohio, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 334) to provide for the recognition of the Lumbee Tribe of Cheraw Indians of North Carolina, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 334) to provide for the recognition
6 of the Lumbee Tribe of Cheraw Indians of North Carolina,

1 and for other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall
2 be dispensed with. Points of order against consideration
3 of the bill for failure to comply with clause 2(l)(2)(B) of
4 rule XI are waived. General debate shall be confined to
5 the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and
6 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member
7 of the Committee on Natural Resources. After general de-
8 bate the bill shall be considered for amendment under the
9 five-minute rule. Each section shall be considered as read.
10 At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amend-
11 ment the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the
12 House with such amendments as may have been adopted.
13 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
14 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without
15 intervening motion except one motion to recommit.
