Mr. MOAKLEY, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2151) to amend the Merchant Marine Act, 1936, to establish the Maritime Security Fleet program, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2151) to amend the Merchant Ma-
6 rine Act, 1936, to establish the Maritime Security Fleet
7 program, and for other purposes. The first reading of the

1 bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall be con-
2 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-
3 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-
4 ity member of the Committee on Merchant Marine and
5 Fisheries. After general debate the bill shall be considered
6 for amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in
7 order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of
8 amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment in
9 the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee
10 on Merchant Marine and Fisheries now printed in the bill.
11 Each section of the committee amendment in the nature
12 of a substitute shall be considered as read. Points of order
13 against the committee amendment in the nature of a sub-
14 stitute for failure to comply with clause 5(a) of rule XXI
15 are waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill
16 for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the
17 bill to the House with such amendments as may have been
18 adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the
19 House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of
20 the Whole to the bill or to the committee amendment in
21 the nature of a substitute. The previous question shall be
22 considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto
23 to final passage without intervening motion except one
24 motion to recommit with or without instructions.
