Mr. SANTORUM submitted the following resolution; which was referred jointly to the Committees on Post Office and Civil Service, House Administration, and Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for greater disclosure of information relating to franked mass mailing and voting records of Members of the House of Representatives.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

3 This resolution may be cited as the “Franking Fair-
4 ness and Voting Disclosure Resolution”.

5 **SEC. 2. MATTER APPROVED FOR FRANKED MASS MAILING**

6 **TO BE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC.**

7 The House Commission on Congressional Mailing
8 Standards and each Member of the House of Representa-
9 tives shall make available to the public for review and

1 copying all matter approved by the Commission for
2 franked mass mailing by the Member. Any copying under
3 the preceding sentence shall be at the expense of the per-
4 son who requests the copying.

5 **SEC. 3. DISCLOSURE OF VOTING RECORDS OF MEMBERS**
6 **OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.**

7 The Doorkeeper of the House of Representatives
8 shall, upon request, disclose to the public the voting record
9 of any Member of the House of Representatives. The dis-
10 closure shall be in a standard format approved by the
11 Committee on House Administration.

12 **SEC. 4. DEFINITION.**

13 As used in this resolution, the term “Member of the
14 House of Representatives” means a Representative in, or
15 a Delegate or Resident Commissioner, to the Congress.
