Mr. BEILENSON, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3759) making emergency supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1994, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3759) making emergency supple-
6 mental appropriations for the fiscal year ending Septem-
7 ber 30, 1994, and for other purposes. The first reading

1 of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order
2 against the bill and against its consideration are waived.
3 General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not
4 exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the
5 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee
6 on Appropriations. After general debate the bill shall be
7 considered for amendment under the five-minute rule and
8 shall be considered as read. No amendment shall be in
9 order except the amendments printed in the report, of the
10 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution. Each
11 amendment may be offered only in the order printed in
12 the report, may be offered only by a Member designated
13 in the report, shall be considered as read, shall be debat-
14 able for the time specified in the report equally divided
15 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, shall
16 not be subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to
17 a demand for division of the question in the House or in
18 the Committee of the Whole. All points of order against
19 the amendments printed in the report are waived. With
20 the concurrence of the minority leader, the amendment
21 numbered 2 in part 1 of the report may be offered in a
22 modified form that is germane to its printed form. If more
23 than one of the amendments printed in part 2 of the re-
24 port is adopted, only the last to be adopted shall be consid-
25 ered as finally adopted and reported to the House. At the

1 conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the
2 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with
3 such amendments as may have been finally adopted. The
4 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the
5 bill and amendments thereto to final passage without in-
6 tervening motion except one motion to recommit.
