RESOLUTION

Providing for motor vehicle leasing for the House of Representatives to be conducted through the General Services Administration.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. MOTOR VEHICLE LEASING FOR THE HOUSE OF**
3 **REPRESENTATIVES TO BE CONDUCTED**
4 **THROUGH THE GENERAL SERVICES ADMINIS-**
5 **TRATION.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in subsection
7 (b), all motor vehicle leasing for the House of Representa-
8 tives shall be conducted through an agreement with the
9 Administrator of General Services. The agreement shall

1 provide for competitive bidding and, with respect to each
2 lease, use of the least expensive motor vehicle that is ap-
3 propriate for the official business involved.

4 (b) EXCEPTION.—A motor vehicle for the House of
5 Representatives may be leased directly, if the terms of the
6 direct lease are equal to or better than the terms available
7 with respect to a lease under subsection (a).

8 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

9 Section 1 shall apply to all leases entered into after
10 the date on which this resolution is agreed to.
