Mr. DECONCINI introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To authorize the Administrator of the General Service Administration to enter into agreements for the construction of border stations on the United States borders with Canada and Mexico, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION.**

4 The Administrator of the General Services Adminis-
5 tration may enter into agreements with State and local
6 governments of the United States for the construction of
7 border stations on the borders of the United States with

1 Canada and Mexico. Agreements under this Act shall be
2 authorized only for facilities—

3 (1) that meet applicable Federal government re-
4 quirements for border stations;

5 (2) that are located on sites approved by the
6 Commissioner of the United States Customs Service,
7 the Commissioner of the Immigration and Natu-
8 ralization Service, the Secretary of Agriculture, and
9 the Administrator of the General Services Adminis-
10 tration; and

11 (3) which have been approved by the Commit-
12 tees on Appropriations of the House of Representa-
13 tives and the Senate, the Public Works and Trans-
14 portation Committee of the House of Representa-
15 tives, and the Environment and Public Works Com-
16 mittee of the Senate.

17 **SEC. 2. TERMS OF AGREEMENTS.**

18 (a) IN GENERAL.—An agreement entered into under
19 this Act shall provide for the acquisition of land and mate-
20 rials for the construction of border stations.

21 (b) TERMS AND LIMITATIONS.—

22 (1) OBLIGATIONS OF FUNDS.—The obligation
23 of the United States under an agreement entered
24 into under this Act shall be limited to the current
25 fiscal year for which payments are due without re-

1 gard to section 3328(a)(1)(B) of title 31, United
2 States Code.

3 (2) DURATION OF AGREEMENT.—An agreement
4 entered into under this Act shall provide for lease or
5 installment payments over a period of not to exceed
6 30 years for the payment of the purchase price and
7 reasonable interest.

8 (3) VESTING OF TITLE.—An agreement entered
9 into under this Act shall provide for the title to the
10 property and facilities to vest in the United States
11 on or before the expiration of the contract term, on
12 fulfillment of the terms and conditions of the agree-
13 ment.

14 **SEC. 3. BUDGETARY TREATMENT.**

15 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, or
16 guidelines or regulations issued pursuant thereto, the obli-
17 gations of the Federal government arising out of an agree-
18 ment entered into under this Act shall be scored each fis-
19 cal year based on the estimated expenditures in the fiscal
20 year.
