A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF METHOD OF COMPUTING AVER-**
4 **AGE SUBSCRIPTION CHARGES FOR FEDERAL**
5 **EMPLOYEE HEALTH BENEFITS PROGRAMS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Act entitled “An Act relating
7 to the method by which Government contributions to the
8 Federal employees health benefits program shall be com-

1 puted for 1990 or 1991 if no Government-wide indemnity
2 benefit plan participates in that year”, approved August
3 11, 1989 (5 U.S.C. 8906 note; Public Law 101–76; 103
4 Stat. 556) is amended in subsection (a)(1) by striking out
5 “contract years 1990 through 1993” and inserting in lieu
6 thereof “contract years 1990 through 1998”.

7 (b) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of the
8 Congress that nothing in this section should be considered
9 to reflect any view on the appropriateness, merits, or tim-
10 ing, or any other aspect of any comprehensive health care
11 reform legislation.

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
