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**A BILL**

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF METHOD OF COMPUTING AVER-**  
2 **AGE SUBSCRIPTION CHARGES FOR FEDERAL**  
3 **EMPLOYEE HEALTH BENEFITS PROGRAMS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Act entitled “An Act relating  
5 to the method by which Government contributions to the  
6 Federal employees health benefits program shall be com-  
7 puted for 1990 or 1991 if no Government-wide indemnity  
8 benefit plan participates in that year”, approved August  
9 11, 1989 (5 U.S.C. 8906 note; Public Law 101–76; 103  
10 Stat. 556) is amended in subsection (a)(1) by striking out  
11 “contract years 1990 through 1993” and inserting in lieu  
12 thereof “contract years 1990 through 1998”.

13 (b) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of the  
14 Congress that nothing in this section should be considered  
15 to reflect any view on the appropriateness, merits, or tim-  
16 ing, or any other aspect of any comprehensive health care  
17 reform legislation.
