Mr. INOUE introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

A BILL

For the relief of the surviving children of Barbara Hutchings and Peter Hutchings.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RETROACTIVE SURVIVOR'S BENEFITS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The provisions of section
5 202(j)(1)(B) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
6 402(j)(1)(B)) shall not apply to the application for survi-
7 vor benefits under section 202(d) of such Act (42 U.S.C.
8 402(d)) filed by Barbara Hutchings on behalf of the sur-
9 viving children of Peter Hutchings of Hawaii, and such

1 application shall be deemed to have been filed before the
2 close of the month of the death of Peter Hutchings.

3 (b) ATTORNEY'S AND AGENT'S FEES.—

4 (1) IN GENERAL.—It shall be unlawful for
5 more than 10 percent of the amount paid pursuant
6 to subsection (a) to be paid to or received by any
7 agent or attorney for any service rendered in connec-
8 tion with the benefits provided by this Act.

9 (2) ENFORCEMENT.—Any person violating the
10 provisions of paragraph (1) shall be fined not more
11 than \$1,000.

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
