A BILL

For the relief of Olga D. Zhondetskaya.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GRANT OF NATURALIZATION TO OLGA D.**
4 **ZHONDETSKAYA.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
6 sion of law, Olga D. Zhondetskaya shall be naturalized
7 as a citizen of the United States upon the filing of the
8 appropriate application and upon being administered the
9 oath of renunciation and allegiance in an appropriate cere-
10 mony pursuant to section 337 of the Immigration and Na-
11 tionality Act.

1 (b) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
2 FEES.—Subsection (a) shall apply only if the application
3 for naturalization is filed with appropriate fees within 1
4 year after the date of the enactment of this Act.
