## A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of Transportation to release restrictions on the use of certain property conveyed to the city of Soldotna, Alaska, for airport purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Soldotna Airport  
5 Improvement Act of 1993”.

6 **SEC. 2. RELEASE.**

7 Notwithstanding section 16 of the Federal Airport  
8 Act (as in effect on December 12, 1963), the Secretary  
9 of Transportation is authorized, subject to the provisions

1 of section 4 of the Act of October 1, 1949 (50 App. U.S.C.  
2 1622c), and the provisions of section 3 of this Act, to  
3 grant releases from any of the terms, conditions, reserva-  
4 tions, and restrictions contained in the deed of conveyance  
5 dated December 12, 1963, under which the United States  
6 conveyed certain property to the city of Soldotna, Alaska,  
7 for airport purposes.

8 **SEC. 3. CONDITIONS.**

9 (a) Any release granted by the Secretary of Transpor-  
10 tation under section 2 of this Act shall be subject to the  
11 following conditions:

12 (1) The city of Soldotna, Alaska, shall agree  
13 that, in conveying any interest in the property which  
14 the United States conveyed to the city by deed dated  
15 December 12, 1963, the city will receive an amount  
16 for such interest which is equal to the fair market  
17 value (as determined pursuant to regulations issued  
18 by the Secretary of Transportation).

19 (2) Any such amount so received by the city  
20 shall be used by the city for the development, im-  
21 provement, operation, or maintenance of a public  
22 airport.
