## A BILL

To authorize appropriations for fiscal years 1994 and 1995 to carry out the National Foundation on the Arts and the Humanities Act of 1965, and the Museum Services Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Arts, Humanities, and  
5 Museums Amendments of 1993”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO THE NATIONAL FOUNDATION ON**  
2 **THE ARTS AND THE HUMANITIES ACT OF**  
3 **1965.**

4 (a) FUNDS AUTHORIZED FOR PROGRAM GRANTS.—  
5 Section 11(a)(1) of the National Foundation on the Arts  
6 and the Humanities Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 960(a)(1))  
7 is amended—

8 (1) in subparagraph (A)—

9 (A) in clause (i) by striking  
10 “\$125,800,000” and all that follows through  
11 “1993”, and inserting “\$119,985,000 for fiscal  
12 year 1994 and such sums as may be necessary  
13 for fiscal year 1995”;

14 (B) by amending clause (ii) to read as fol-  
15 lows:

16 “(ii) Not less than 27.5 percent of the amount appro-  
17 priated under clause (i) for each of the fiscal years 1994  
18 and 1995 shall be for carrying out section 5(g).”; and

19 (C) in the first sentence of clause (iii) by  
20 striking “For” and all that follows through  
21 “shall”, and inserting “Not less than 7.5 per-  
22 cent of the amount appropriated under clause  
23 (i) for each of the fiscal years 1994 and 1995  
24 shall”; and

25 (2) in the first sentence of subparagraph (B) by  
26 striking “\$119,900,000” and all that follows

1 through “1993”, and inserting “\$130,573,000 for  
2 fiscal year 1994 and such sums as may be necessary  
3 for fiscal year 1995”.

4 (b) FUNDS AUTHORIZED TO MATCH NON-FEDERAL  
5 FUNDS RECEIVED.—Section 11(a) of the National Foun-  
6 dation on the Arts and the Humanities Act of 1965 (20  
7 U.S.C. 960(a)) is amended—

8 (1) in paragraph (2)—

9 (A) in subparagraph (A)—

10 (i) by striking “1993” the first place  
11 the term appears and inserting “1995”;  
12 and

13 (ii) by striking “\$13,000,000” and all  
14 that follows through “1993”, and inserting  
15 “\$16,955,000 for fiscal year 1994 and  
16 such sums as may be necessary for fiscal  
17 year 1995”; and

18 (B) in subparagraph (B)—

19 (i) by striking “1993” the first place  
20 the term appears and inserting “1995”;  
21 and

22 (ii) by striking “\$12,000,000” and all  
23 that follows through “1993”, and inserting  
24 “\$11,963,000 for fiscal year 1994 and

1           such sums as may be necessary for fiscal  
2           year 1995”;

3           (2) in paragraph (3)—

4           (A) in subparagraph (A)—

5                 (i) by striking “1993” the first place  
6                 the term appears and inserting “1995”;  
7                 and

8                 (ii) by striking “\$15,000,000” and all  
9                 that follows through “1993”, and inserting  
10                “\$13,187,000 for fiscal year 1994 and  
11                such sums as may be necessary for fiscal  
12                year 1995”; and

13           (B) in subparagraph (B)—

14                 (i) by striking “1993” the first place  
15                 the term appears and inserting “1995”;  
16                 and

17                 (ii) by striking “\$15,150,000” and all  
18                 that follows through “1993”, and inserting  
19                 “\$14,228,000 for fiscal year 1994 and  
20                 such sums as may be necessary for fiscal  
21                 year 1995”; and

22           (3) in the last sentence of paragraph (4) by  
23           striking “section 5(l)(2)” and inserting “section  
24           5(p)(2)”.

1 (c) FUNDS AUTHORIZED FOR ADMINISTRATION OF  
2 PROGRAMS OF THE NATIONAL ENDOWMENTS.—Section  
3 11(c) of the National Foundation on the Arts and the Hu-  
4 manities Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 960(c)) is amended—

5 (1) in paragraph (1) by striking “\$21,200,000”  
6 and all that follows through “1993”, and inserting  
7 “\$24,466,000 for fiscal year 1994 and such sums as  
8 may be necessary for fiscal year 1995”; and

9 (2) in paragraph (2) by striking “\$17,950,000”  
10 and all that follows through “1993”, and inserting  
11 “\$20,727,000 for fiscal year 1994 and such sums as  
12 may be necessary for fiscal year 1995”.

13 (d) LIMITATIONS ON TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS AU-  
14 THORIZED.—Section 11(d) of the National Foundation on  
15 the Arts and the Humanities Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C.  
16 960(d)) is amended—

17 (1) in paragraph (1) by striking “exceed” and  
18 all that follows through the period at the end, and  
19 inserting “exceed \$174,593,000 for fiscal year  
20 1994.”; and

21 (2) in paragraph (2) by striking “exceed” and  
22 all that follows through the period at the end, and  
23 inserting “exceed \$177,491,000 for fiscal year  
24 1994.”.

1 **SEC. 3. AMENDMENTS TO THE MUSEUM SERVICES ACT.**

2 Section 209 of the Museum Services Act (20 U.S.C.  
3 967) is amended—

4 (1) in subsection (a) by striking “\$24,000,000”  
5 and all that follows through “1993”, and inserting  
6 “\$28,777,000 for fiscal year 1994 and such sums as  
7 may be necessary for fiscal year 1995”; and

8 (2) in subsection (d) by striking “1993” and in-  
9 serting “1995”.
