## A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to unify the reauthorization cycle with respect to Centers for Disease Control and Prevention programs, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “CDC Reauthorization  
5 Unification Act of 1993”.

1 **SEC. 2. ALIGNMENT OF CURRENT CENTERS FOR DISEASE**  
2 **CONTROL AND PREVENTION REAUTHORIZA-**  
3 **TION SCHEDULE.**

4 (a) **LEAD POISONING PREVENTION.**—Section  
5 317A(l)(1) of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C.  
6 247b-1(l)(1)) is amended by striking “through 1997” and  
7 inserting “and 1995”.

8 (b) **PROSTATE CANCER PREVENTION.**—Section  
9 317D(l)(1) of such Act (42 U.S.C. 247b-5(l)(1)) is  
10 amended by striking “through 1996” and inserting “and  
11 1995”.

12 (c) **CANCER REGISTRIES.**—Section 399L(a) of such  
13 Act (42 U.S.C. 280e-4(a)) (as amended by section  
14 2003(1) of Public Law 103-43) is amended by striking  
15 “each of the fiscal years 1995 through 1996” and insert-  
16 ing “fiscal year 1995”.

17 (d) **HEALTH PROMOTION AND DISEASE PREVENTION**  
18 **RESEARCH AND DEMONSTRATION CENTERS.**—Section  
19 1706(e) of such Act (42 U.S.C. 300u-5(e)) is amended  
20 by striking “through 1996” and inserting “through  
21 1995”.

22 (e) **PREVENTIVE HEALTH AND HEALTH SERVICES**  
23 **BLOCK GRANTS.**—Section 1901(a) of such Act (42 U.S.C.  
24 300w(a)) is amended by striking “through 1997” and in-  
25 serting “and 1995”.

1 **SEC. 3. SENSE OF CONGRESS.**

2       It is the sense of Congress that, beginning on the  
3 date of enactment of this Act and continuing through fis-  
4 cal year 1995, all Acts regarding the authorization or re-  
5 authorization of Centers for Disease Control and Preven-  
6 tion programs should be authorized only through fiscal  
7 year 1995. Beginning in fiscal year 1995, Congress should  
8 reauthorize the Centers for Disease Control and Preven-  
9 tion and its programs in one comprehensive Act. After fis-  
10 cal year 1995, reauthorization of such Centers and its pro-  
11 grams should occur on a regular cyclical basis.
