Mr. HATCH (for himself, Mr. KENNEDY, Ms. MIKULSKI, Mr. DURENBERGER, and Mr. DODD) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Labor and Human Resources

A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to require that certain entities provide information concerning breast and cervical cancer, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Breast and Cervical
5 Cancer Information Act of 1993”.

6 **SEC. 2. BREAST AND CERVICAL CANCER INFORMATION.**

7 Title XXVII of the Public Health Service Act (42
8 U.S.C. 300aaa et seq.) is amended by adding at the end
9 the following new section:

1 **“SEC. 2715. BREAST AND CERVICAL CANCER INFORMATION.**

2 “(a) IN GENERAL.—Each of the entities referred to
3 in subsection (b) shall make available, to such individuals
4 as the entities determine appropriate, information (in a
5 culturally competent manner) concerning breast and cer-
6 vical cancer, including if appropriate, information on the
7 need for breast self-examinations and the skills for such
8 self-examinations, and shall refer such clients as the enti-
9 ties determine appropriate for breast and cervical cancer
10 screening, treatment or other services.

11 “(b) ENTITIES.—The entities referred to in sub-
12 section (a) are—

13 “(1) a migrant health center receiving assist-
14 ance under section 329;

15 “(2) a community health center receiving assist-
16 ance under section 330;

17 “(3) an entity receiving assistance under sec-
18 tion 340;

19 “(4) an alcohol or drug treatment entity or
20 mental health entity receiving assistance under title
21 V or title XIX;

22 “(5) a family planning project described in sec-
23 tion 1001;

24 “(6) an entity receiving assistance under title
25 XXVI;

1 “(7) a clinic that treats sexually transmitted
2 diseases and is authorized under section 318;

3 “(8) an entity receiving funds to provide pri-
4 mary health services to residents of public housing
5 under section 340A;

6 “(9) a non-Federal entity authorized under the
7 Indian Self-Determination Act; and

8 “(10) a tuberculosis clinic receiving assistance
9 under section 317(j)(2) or 317(k)(2).”.

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
