## **AN ACT**

For the relief of the Menominee Indian Tribe of Wisconsin.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 SECTION 1. The Secretary of the Treasury is author-  
2 ized and directed to pay to the Menominee Indian Tribe  
3 of Wisconsin, out of any money in the Treasury of the  
4 United States not otherwise appropriated, a sum equal to  
5 the damages sustained by the Menominee Indian Tribe of  
6 Wisconsin by reason of—

7 (a) the enactment and implementation of the  
8 Act of June 17, 1954 (68 Stat. 250), as amended,  
9 and

10 (b) the mismanagement by the United States of  
11 Menominee assets held in trust by the United States  
12 prior to April 30, 1961, the effective date of termi-  
13 nation of Federal supervision of the Menominee In-  
14 dian Tribe of Wisconsin.

15 SEC. 2. Payment of the sum referred to in section  
16 1 shall be in full satisfaction of any claims that the Me-  
17 nominee Indian Tribe of Wisconsin may have against the  
18 United States with respect to the damages referred to in  
19 such section.
