## A BILL

For the relief of the Menominee Indian Tribe of Wisconsin.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        SECTION 1. The Secretary of the Treasury is author-  
4        ized and directed to pay to the Menominee Indian Tribe  
5        of Wisconsin, out of any money in the Treasury of the  
6        United States not otherwise appropriated, a sum equal to  
7        the damages sustained by the Menominee Indian Tribe of  
8        Wisconsin by reason of—

1           (a) the enactment and implementation of the  
2 Act of June 17, 1954 (68 Stat. 250), as amended,  
3 and

4           (b) the mismanagement by the United States of  
5 Menominee assets held in trust by the United States  
6 prior to April 30, 1961, the effective date of termi-  
7 nation of Federal supervision of the Menominee In-  
8 dian Tribe of Wisconsin.

9       SEC. 2. Payment of the sum referred to in section  
10 1 shall be in full satisfaction of any claims that the Me-  
11 nominee Indian Tribe of Wisconsin may have against the  
12 United States with respect to the damages referred to in  
13 such section.
