A BILL

To eliminate the discount on office equipment and furniture for Senators departing office.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF DISCOUNT ON OFFICE EQUIPMENT**
4 **AND FURNITURE FOR SENATORS DEPARTING**
5 **OFFICE.**

6 The Act entitled “An Act to authorize the disposition
7 of certain office equipment and furnishings, and for other
8 purposes” (2 U.S.C. 59b) is repealed.
