Mr. CRAIG introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred
to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To revise the boundaries of the Hagerman Fossil Beds
National Monument, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Hagerman Fossil Beds
5 National Monument Boundary Revision Act of 1993”.

6 **SEC. 2. BOUNDARY REVISION.**

7 Section 302(a) of the Arizona-Idaho Conservation
8 Act of 1988 (102 Stat. 4571) is amended—

9 (1) by striking “(a) The Secretary” and insert-
10 ing “(a)(1) The Secretary”; and

1 (2) by adding at the end the following new
2 paragraph:

3 “(2) The Secretary is authorized to acquire from will-
4 ing sellers, by donation, with donated or appropriated
5 funds, or exchange, not more than 65 acres outside the
6 boundary depicted on the map referred to in section 301
7 for the purpose of developing the land and operating re-
8 search, information, interpretive, and administrative facili-
9 ties. Lands acquired and facilities developed under this
10 paragraph shall be administered by the Secretary as part
11 of the monument. The boundary of the monument shall
12 be modified to include the lands added under this para-
13 graph as a noncontiguous parcel.”.
