A BILL

To redesignate the J. Edgar Hoover Federal Bureau of Investigation Building located at Ninth and Pennsylvania Avenue, NW., Washington, DC, as the Federal Bureau of Investigation Building.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION AND RENAMING OF THE FED-**
4 **ERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION BUILDING.**

5 (a) REDESIGNATION.—The J. Edgar Hoover Federal
6 Bureau of Investigation Building located at Ninth and

1 Pennsylvania Avenue, NW., Washington, DC, is redesignated as the Federal Bureau of Investigation Building.

3 (b) SIGNS.—The Administrator of the General Services Administration shall cause all signs and engravings designating the J. Edgar Hoover Federal Bureau of Investigation Building to read the Federal Bureau of Investigation Building.

8 (c) LEGAL REFERENCES.—Any reference in any law, regulation, document, record, map, or other paper of the United States to the J. Edgar Hoover Federal Bureau of Investigation Building shall be deemed to be a reference to the “Federal Bureau of Investigation Building”.
