Mr. DANFORTH introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation

A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of Transportation to release restrictions imposed in connection with the conveyance of certain lands to the city of Rolla, Missouri.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Rolla Airport Improve-
5 ment Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION TO GRANT RELEASES.**

7 Notwithstanding section 16 of the Federal Airport
8 Act (as in effect on December 30, 1957), the Secretary
9 of Transportation is authorized, subject to the provisions

1 of section 4 of the Act of October 1, 1949 (50 App. U.S.C.
2 1622c), and the provisions of section 3 of this Act, to
3 grant releases from any of the terms, conditions, reserva-
4 tions, and restrictions contained in the deed of conveyance
5 dated December 30, 1957, or any other deed of convey-
6 ance dated after such date and before the date of enact-
7 ment of this Act, under which the United States conveyed
8 certain property to the city of Rolla, Missouri, for airport
9 purposes.

10 **SEC. 3. CONDITIONS.**

11 Any release granted under section 2 of this Act shall
12 be subject to the following conditions:

13 (1) The city of Rolla, Missouri, shall agree that,
14 in conveying any interest in the property which the
15 United States conveyed to the city by a deed de-
16 scribed in section 2, the city will receive an amount
17 for such interest which is equal to the fair market
18 value (as determined pursuant to regulations issued
19 by the Secretary of Transportation).

20 (2) Any such amount so received by the city
21 shall be used by the city for the development, im-
22 provement, operation, or maintenance of a public
23 airport.
