A BILL

To require the Director of the Federal Emergency Management Agency to establish a FEMA region for the Pacific, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FEMA REGION FOR THE PACIFIC.**

4 The Director of the Federal Emergency Management
5 Agency shall establish a region of the Federal Emergency
6 Management Agency for the Pacific region, that encom-
7 passes—

8 (1) Hawaii, which shall serve as headquarters
9 for the region;

10 (2) American Samoa;

1 (3) Guam;

2 (4) the Commonwealth of the Northern Mari-
3 ana Islands;

4 (5) the Federated States of Micronesia;

5 (6) the Republic of Palau (until such time as
6 the Compact of Free Association is ratified); and

7 (7) the Republic of the Marshall Islands.

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
