## A BILL

To amend the Central Bering Sea Fisheries Enforcement  
Act of 1992.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Sea of Okhotsk Fish-  
5 eries Enforcement Act of 1993”.

6 **SEC. 2. FISHING PROHIBITION.**

7 The Central Bering Sea Fisheries Enforcement Act  
8 of 1992 (title III of Public Law 102–582, 16 U.S.C. 1823  
9 note) is amended—

1           (1) in section 302, by inserting the words “and  
2 the Central Sea of Okhotsk” after “Central Bering  
3 Sea”;

4           (2) in section 306, by renumbering paragraphs  
5 (2) through (6) as paragraphs (3) through (7), re-  
6 spectively; and

7           (3) in section 306, by inserting the following  
8 new paragraph:

9           “(2) CENTRAL SEA OF OKHOTSK.—The term  
10 ‘Central Sea of Okhotsk’ means the central Sea of  
11 Okhotsk area which is more than two hundred nau-  
12 tical miles seaward of the baselines from which the  
13 breadth of the territorial sea of the Russian Federa-  
14 tion is measured.”.
