AN ACT

To amend title 38, United States Code, to repeal a requirement that the Under Secretary for Health in the Department of Veterans Affairs be a doctor of medicine.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF REQUIREMENT THAT UNDER SEC-**
4 **RETARY OF VETERANS AFFAIRS FOR HEALTH**
5 **BE A DOCTOR OF MEDICINE.**

6 (a) REPEAL.—Subsection (a)(2) of section 305 of
7 title 38, United States Code, is amended—

8 (1) in the matter preceding subparagraph (A),
9 by striking out “shall be a doctor of medicine and”;
10 and

11 (2) in subparagraph (A)—

1 (A) by striking out “in the medical profes-
2 sion,”; and

3 (B) by striking out the comma after “pol-
4 icy formulation”.

5 (b) TECHNICAL CORRECTION.—Subsection (a)(1) of
6 such section is amended by striking out “a Under Sec-
7 retary” and inserting in lieu thereof “an Under Sec-
8 retary”.
