## A BILL

For the relief of The Triax Company, a Utah corporation.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SATISFACTION OF CLAIM AGAINST THE UNITED**  
4 **STATES.**

5 (a) PAYMENT.—The Secretary of the Treasury shall  
6 pay, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise ap-  
7 propriated, the sum of \$2,800,000 to The Triax Company,  
8 a Utah corporation.

9 (b) BASIS.—The payment required by subsection (a)  
10 shall be in full compensation of any claim of The Triax  
11 Company against the United States arising out of a con-  
12 tract at Memphis Naval Air Station, Millington, Ten-

1 nessee, for the rehabilitation of 486 housing units of  
2 Wherry Housing (Contract No. N62467-80-C-0099).

3 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON ATTORNEY'S AND AGENT'S FEES.**

4 Not more than 10 percent of the payment specified  
5 in section 1 may be paid to or received by any agent or  
6 attorney as consideration for any services rendered in con-  
7 nection with this Act, notwithstanding any contract which  
8 provides otherwise. Any person who violates this section  
9 shall be fined not more than \$50,000.
