## AN ACT

To expand the boundaries of the Piscataway National Park,  
and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Piscataway National  
5 Park Expansion Act of 1994”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXPANSION OF PARK.**

2 (a) The boundaries of Piscataway Park in Maryland  
3 are hereby revised to reflect the addition of approximately  
4 163 acres of lands as generally depicted on the map enti-  
5 tled “Proposed Boundary Map—Piscataway Park”, num-  
6 bered 838–80137, and dated November 17, 1993.

7 (b) The Secretary of the Interior is authorized to ac-  
8 quire lands and interests therein within the areas added  
9 to the park pursuant to subsection (a) by donation, pur-  
10 chase with donated or appropriated funds, or exchange.

11 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

12 There is authorized to be appropriated such sums as  
13 are necessary to carry out this Act.

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to expand the  
boundaries of Piscataway Park, and for other purposes.”.
