## A BILL

To extend temporarily the suspension of duty on certain chemicals.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON CER-**  
4 **TAIN CHEMICALS.**

18 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

19 (a) IN GENERAL.—The amendments made by section  
20 1 apply with respect to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
21 warehouse for consumption on or after the 15th day after  
22 the date of the enactment of this Act.

23 (b) RETROACTIVE PROVISION.—Notwithstanding sec-  
24 tion 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930 or any other provision  
25 of law, upon a request filed with the appropriate customs

1 officer on or before the 90th day after the date of the  
2 enactment of this Act, any entry or withdrawal from ware-  
3 house for consumption of goods to which the amendment  
4 made by section 1 applies and that was made—

5 (1) after December 31, 1992; and

6 (2) before the 15th day after the date of the en-  
7 actment of this Act;

8 and with respect to which there would have been a lower  
9 duty if the amendment made by section 1 had applied to  
10 such entry or withdrawal, shall be liquidated or  
11 reliquidated as though such entry or withdrawal had oc-  
12 curred on such 15th day.
