A BILL

To amend the National Wool Act of 1954 to provide that the reduction in the support price for wool and mohair and the elimination of the wool and mohair programs do not apply to households who are participating, or are eligible to participate, in the food stamp program, and for other purposes.

1 **SECTION 1. EXEMPTION OF FOOD STAMP HOUSEHOLDS**
2 **FROM REDUCTION OR ELIMINATION OF**
3 **WOOL AND MOHAIR PROGRAMS.**

4 (a) SUPPORT PRICE FOR WOOL AND MOHAIR.—Sec-
5 tion 703 of the National Wool Act of 1954 (7 U.S.C.
6 1782) is amended—

7 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “through De-
8 cember 31, 1995.” and inserting “through—

9 “(1) December 31, 1995; or

10 “(2) in the case of a household that is partici-
11 pating, or is eligible to participate, in the food stamp
12 program established under the Food Stamp Act of
13 1977 (7 U.S.C. 2011 et seq.) (referred to in this Act
14 as a ‘food stamp household’), December 31, 1997.”;
15 and

16 (2) in subsection (b)—

17 (A) in paragraph (2), by inserting after
18 “1995” the following: “(or, in the case of a
19 food stamp household, December 31, 1997)”;

20 (B) in paragraph (3), by striking “No”
21 and inserting “In the case of producers of wool
22 and mohair other than food stamp households,
23 no”; and

24 (C) in paragraph (4)(A), by inserting after
25 “1995” the following: “(or, in the case of a
26 food stamp household, December 31, 1997)”.

1 (b) REDUCTION IN PAYMENTS.—The second sentence
2 of section 704(a) of such Act (7 U.S.C. 1783(a)) is
3 amended by inserting after “In the case of” the following:
4 “wool and mohair marketed by producers, other than food
5 stamp households, for”.

6 (c) ELIMINATION OF WOOL AND MOHAIR PRO-
7 GRAMS.—Section 3 of Public Law 103–130 (7 U.S.C.
8 1781 note) is amended—

9 (1) by striking subsections (a) and (b); and

10 (2) in subsection (c), by striking “(c) PROHIBI-
11 TION.—Effective” and inserting “In the case of a
12 producer other than a household that is participat-
13 ing, or is eligible to participate, in the food stamp
14 program established under the Food Stamp Act of
15 1977 (7 U.S.C. 2011 et seq.), effective”.
