A BILL

To provide for mandatory life imprisonment of a person convicted of a second offense of kidnapping a minor.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Child Abduction Pre-
5 vention Act” (CAP Act).

6 **SEC. 2. MANDATORY LIFE IMPRISONMENT FOR A SECOND**

7 **KIDNAPPING OF A MINOR.**

8 Section 1201(g) of title 18, United States Code, is
9 amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (1) by striking “paragraph
2 (2)” and inserting “paragraphs (2) and (3)”; and

3 (2) by adding at the end the following new
4 paragraph:

5 “(3) SECOND OFFENSE.—An offender described
6 in paragraph (1)(B) who commits an offense under
7 this section in which the victim has not attained the
8 age of 18 years shall be punished by imprisonment
9 for life.”.
