## A BILL

For the relief of Joe W. Floyd.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. ENTITLEMENT TO RETIRED PAY.**

4       (a) ENTITLEMENT.—Notwithstanding any other pro-  
5       vision of law, Joe W. Floyd of Holcomb, Mississippi, shall  
6       be entitled to retired pay under section 1331 of title 10,  
7       United States Code, as if such individual had completed  
8       20 years of creditable service in the Army and the Army  
9       Reserve. Such individual shall submit an application for  
10      retired pay in accordance with subsection (b) of such sec-  
11      tion.

1       (b) APPLICABILITY.—Retired pay shall be paid to the  
2 individual referred to in subsection (a) only for months  
3 beginning after the date of the application referred to in  
4 such subsection.
