A BILL

To amend the Trade Act of 1974 to make “super 301”
permanent.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. IDENTIFICATION OF TRADE LIBERALIZATION**

4 **PRIORITIES MADE PERMANENT.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 310(a) of the Trade Act
6 of 1974 (19 U.S.C. 2420(a)) is amended—

7 (1) by striking “By no later than the date that
8 is 30 days after the date in calendar year 1989, and
9 also the date in calendar year 1990, on which the
10 report required under section 181(b) is submitted to
11 the appropriate Congressional committees,” and in-

1 serting “By no later than the date that is 180 days
2 after the date on which the report required under
3 section 181(b) is submitted to the appropriate Con-
4 gressional committees,” and

5 (2) by striking “such report” in subparagraph
6 (B) and inserting “the most recent report submitted
7 under section 181(b)”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
9 this section shall apply to calendar years beginning after
10 1993.

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
